

Self-Paced ASAM Criteria Training

To be completed by September 30, 2022

Who can attend: Only those who have never taken ASAM Criteria Skill Building (Two Day Skill Building) in the past 5 years. Please note this is not the same training as the ASAM Continuum.

Training Description: This interactive self-paced course is comprised of reading and recorded videos. The flow of this course uses a mix of didactic materials, case studies, learning activities, and assessments to help you understand the underlying principles of the ASAM Criteria, how to conduct a multidimensional patient assessment and determine an appropriate level of care. Further, by utilizing real-world scenarios, the course will prepare you to implement the ASAM Criteria effectively within the context of system challenges. This a beginner level course that you will need to complete no later than September 30, 2022. **Please note no CE's will be given by CMHA for this self-paced course.**

Registration & Approval Process:

1. The attendee must be referred directly through SWMBH

 3. Once approved, the attendee will receive a link from CMHA to register and pay for the course.
