PA2 Reporting and Planning	Reminder that all programs who receive PA2 funding for treatment programs, outcome reports will be due May 11, 2016. A template will be provided for providers to fill out. This will go to the SUD Board for review. Additionally, planning for next year's PA2 budget will begin shortly. Meetings with counties will be scheduled to begin planning process.	Outcome report due May 11.
Financials	Jamie reviewed SUD financial information through February 2016.	
Share Point Access	SWMBH has been utilizing share point for CMHSPs and would like to offer it to SUD providers. Reports specific to SUD providers will be located here. Sign up sheet was sent around for agencies to identify one or two key staff at each provider who will be granted access.	
Evidence Based Practice Updates	Aggregate data was shared with the group. Those providers that are currently under the 80% metric has been contacted. Updates will continue to be provided throughout the year.	
SUD Treatment RFP	Reminder that the SUD treatment RFP is due on June 14, 2016.	June 14 RFP due.
Naloxone Project Update	Mindie updated providers on the number of law enforcement agencies that have been trained.	
Governor's Proposed Budget Update	Most recent memo from MACMHB was reviewed. Work group has been developed to address the current 298 language.	

Training Plan: SBIRT, CBT	CBT (Beck Institute) will be providing training for depression, anxiety and SUD this summer – June and July. SWMBH also be working to secure an SBIRT trainer for fall 2016.	
Treatment Plans	Mindie reminded providers to please review treatment plans of clinical staff. They continue to be sub par and result in authorizations being pended, denied, etc.	
Case Management Utilization	CSM utilization has been very low. Reminder that this service needs to be offered as an outpatient service and this metric will continue to be monitored.	
Encounter Reporting	SMWBH has been able to successfully submit SUD encounters over the past few months under the new BH TEDS system. One of the few PIHPs in the state that have been able to do so.	
Misc	Sean Harris from Recovery Institute provided information about an upcoming tobacco free training (Colorado University curriculum). Information was distributed. Also announced that Healing Voices will be shown at KRESA on 5/3.
